All requirements of the Association's Mitigation Plan must continue to be followed except for specific areas identified below. All Association participants agree to adhere to these established mitigation protocols. If a team does not adhere to established UAF or Association mitigation protocols they may lose ice time or incur additional fees as determined by the facility or Association. If individual players, coaches or spectators are unable to follow established protocols, the Association or facility may suspend them from future use of the facility.

Rink Capacity:

Maximum of 32 players (plus 4 coaches) on the ice at one time. Allowing for split team or full team practices. The Alaska Grizzlies Academy may have 30 players and six (6) coaches on ice. Entrance into the building is from the east end and exit is on the west end.

Games:

- Games may only be played with teams from within the Fairbanks North Star Borough. No outside teams may be played during this phase.
- Maximum of 32 players participating per game, two (2) referees, two (2) coaches per bench, and two (2) score keepers. Penalty box's may be manned by a volunteer, but the volunteer must exit the penalty box immediately after the player enters the box and remain outside the box until just before allowing the player to reenter the ice. Any non-player participant not on the ice must wear a mask.
- Teams will also be given additional bench seating to promote social distancing during gameplay.
- Home teams will come to the rink dressed. They will utilize seats 2-18 to get skates on.
- Visiting teams will come to the rink dressed. They will utilize seats 19-33 and 1 to get skates on.
- Home and Visiting fans will have designated seating spaces. Spectators for each team will be separated in the bleachers by a whole section.
- Limit of two (2) family members per game participant, for a maximum of 64 spectators.
- Clusters will not be allowed, including by the arena main doors nearest the Skate Room.
- Home team will communicate with the visiting team the UAF required screening questionnaire. The visiting team is responsible for ensuring compliance of the mitigation plan with their team and spectators.
- Home team will be responsible for ensuring health screenings (utilizing TeamSnap) are completed by every player and coach in attendance for their team. Home team will also ensure spectators, referees and scorekeepers have the information to complete the UAF required screening questionnaire.
- Visiting teams will be responsible for the UAF required screening questionnaire is completed for all players, coaches and spectators.
- Home and visiting teams will enter and exit the rink at different designated rink doors.

Shared Practices:

- Team 1 will utilize seats 2-18 to get skates on.
- Team 2 team will utilize seats 19-33 and 1 to get skates on.
- Limit of 2 family members per practice for a maximum of 64 people, socially distanced and masked in stands.
- Clusters will not be allowed, including by the arena main doors nearest the Skate Room.
- Each team will be responsible for ensuring health screenings are completed by every player and coach in attendance.

Cleaning and Sanitizing:

- UAF staff will be responsible for cleaning and sanitizing benches, handles, doors or other high touch surfaces between each user group.
- Players, coaches, spectators and other participants are encouraged to utilize hand sanitizer when entering the facility.
