

UAF VISITING TEAM GAME RULES



- You must be a team located within the Fairbanks North Star Borough.
- Maximum of 32 players participating per game, two (2) referees, two (2) coaches per bench, and two (2) score keepers. Penalty box's may be manned by a volunteer, but the volunteer must exit the penalty box immediately after the player enters the box and remain outside the box until just before allowing the player to reenter the ice. Any non-player participant not on the ice must wear a mask.
- Teams will be given additional bench seating to promote social distancing during gameplay.
- Team areas will be staged at opposite sides of the rink for getting skates on and off. Players must come dressed in gear with exception of skates, gloves and helmets. Goalies can add pads at rink.
 - 1. All teams will enter on the east side of the building and exit on the west end.
 - 2. Home teams will utilize seats 2-18 to get skates on/off.
 - 3. Visiting team will utilize seats 19-33 and 1 to get skates on/off.
 - 4. Entrance and exit for the ice will be designated for each team.
 - 5. Home and visiting teams will promptly exit the ice at the completion of each game and return to the same seating to remove their skates and promptly leave the building.
- Home and visiting fans will have designated seating spaces. Spectators for each team will be separated in the bleachers by a whole section. Spectators must exit the building immediately following each game.
- Limit of two (2) family members per game participant, for a maximum of 64 spectators.
- Clusters will not be allowed, including by the arena main doors nearest the Skate Room.
- Visiting teams will follow UAF required screening questionnaire and the UAF Mitigation Plan found on UAF's <u>website</u> or scan this code with your smart phone camera or QR app or visit this <u>website</u>.



- The visiting team is responsible for ensuring compliance of the mitigation plan and questionnaire with their team and spectators.
- Home team or team responsible for securing referees and scorekeepers will ensure referees and scorekeepers have the information to complete the UAF required screening questionnaire.
- All patrons must follow the directional flow of the rink and enter/exit in the designated areas.
